Step 1.

Paint your PVA glue over the top half of the canvas, then carefully lay down the wallpaper you've printed from the end of this document. Seal with Matt Acrylic Medium once you're done.



Step 2.

Draw in the rough shape of the chair, based on the image at the end of this document. If you want to use less wallpaper, you can do this before you glue it on, so you can put it around where the chair will be, rather than under where you'll be painting over anyway.



Step 3.

Cut out scraps of fabric and arrange on the canvas in a way that pleases you. Make sure you follow the curves of the chair, so it doesn't look too flat.



Step 4.

Paint different patches of colour on the chair, give it some character, make it represent YOU. Be sure to keep the background neutral, though!



TRY TO REMEMBER EVERYTHING YOU KNOW ABOUT COLOUR THEORY, AND THEN FORGET IT, FOR THIS LESSON!

Step 5.

Build the photo-frame with thick cardboard, like the back of a paper or canvas pad.



Step 6.

Apply gold leafing to the frame, then stick it to your finished painting!
