

# Easter Egg Decoration

..Hello and happy Easter everybody today we'll be decorating some eggs for Easter, so grab your art materials and...

Lets get into it!



What we used:

MAXX0024	Mont Marte Leafing Size
MAXX0021	Mont Marte Silver Leaf
MAXX0022	Mont Marte Gold Leaf
MCG0037	Mont Marte Acrylic Paints 12 pce
MCG0108	Mont Marte Taklon Bright #12
MCG0112	Mont Marte Taklon Round #2

Glitter  
Eggs



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### Step 1. Removing the yolk from the egg

We must remove the yolk from the egg so it doesn't go off. To do this create a little hole in the top of the egg & a slightly larger one in the bottom of the egg. I used a point from the Clay Tool Set but a corkscrew can do the same trick. Once the holes have been created blow in to the top hole & yolk will be forced out of the bottom hole. Do this to 3 eggs.

## The Golden Egg

### Step 1. Painting the first egg

The first egg I paint Orange. I use the number 12 Taklon flat to lay on this colour. Let this dry.



### Step 2. Painting on the size

Squeeze out some size and then cover the entire egg as evenly as you can. Let this dry. This will take about 20 minutes. I have made a little card tube to sit my eggs on while they dry.



### Step 3. Applying the Gold Leaf

Take the leaf booklet and lay it on a flat surface. Expose the leaf sheet and roll the egg over it. Fold the leaf over the top and bottom of the sheet on to the egg so it is fully covered. Take the number 12 Taklon brush and remove any loose unadhered leaf.



## Silver Script Egg

### Step 1. Painting the second egg

The second egg I paint Green. I use the number 12 taklon flat to lay on this colour.

If you don't want to keep your eggs for very long you can hard boil them.







#### Step 2. Painting on the size

Using the number 2 brush lay in thin lines in a curving script type of style. let this dry. This will take 20 minutes.

#### Step 3. Applying the Silver leaf

Take the leaf booklet and lay it on to a flat surface. Expose the leaf sheet and roll the egg over it. Make sure the entire egg is covered. Next take the number 12 brush and gently remove any loose unadhered bits of leaf.

## The Glittery Egg

#### Step 1. Painting the third egg

This third egg I paint blue. I use the number 12 Taklon flat to lay this colour on. I then let this dry.

#### Step 2. Painting on the size

Because there will be three colours of glitter on this egg I need to lay down the coats consecutively. First I lay on the top. Let this dry.

#### Step 5. Applying the Glitter

Lay the pink glitter on to the top sized portion of the egg. Next lay some size in a band across the centre of the egg, let this dry and apply some gold glitter. Finally paint some size on to the remaining bottom portion of the egg, and when this is dry sprinkle over some blue glitter.

Well done! Now you can sit back and admire your eggs . I hope you enjoyed this lesson and I hope everyone has a really arty and fun Easter break....
