Step 1.

Set up your Muse. We sat him on a teapot, but you might use some books to support his back, or even make a simple wire stand. You just need to be able to see him clearly.



Step 2.

Start drawing up your teddy. Be sure to draw a round head, a round body, sausages for arms and legs, and don't forget his nose, eyes, ears and mouth.



Step 3.

Add the 'Super' details. You can give your Teddy a cape and a sword, like Joe's, or maybe you'd like to give him a gun or lazerbeam eyes?



Step 4.

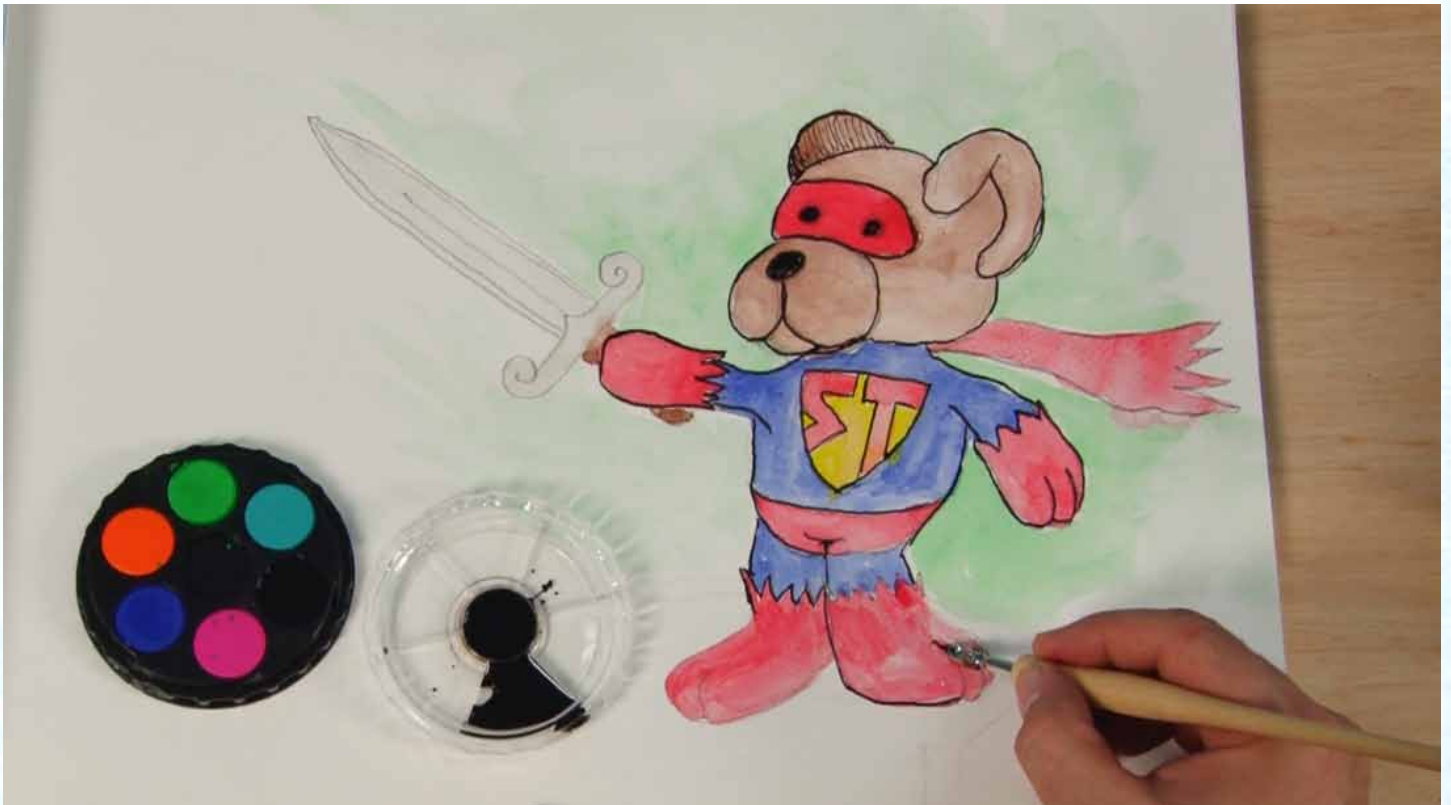
Paint your Super Teddy with your favourite (most heroic!) colours



USE LESS WATER TO MAKE YOUR COLOURS STRONGER!

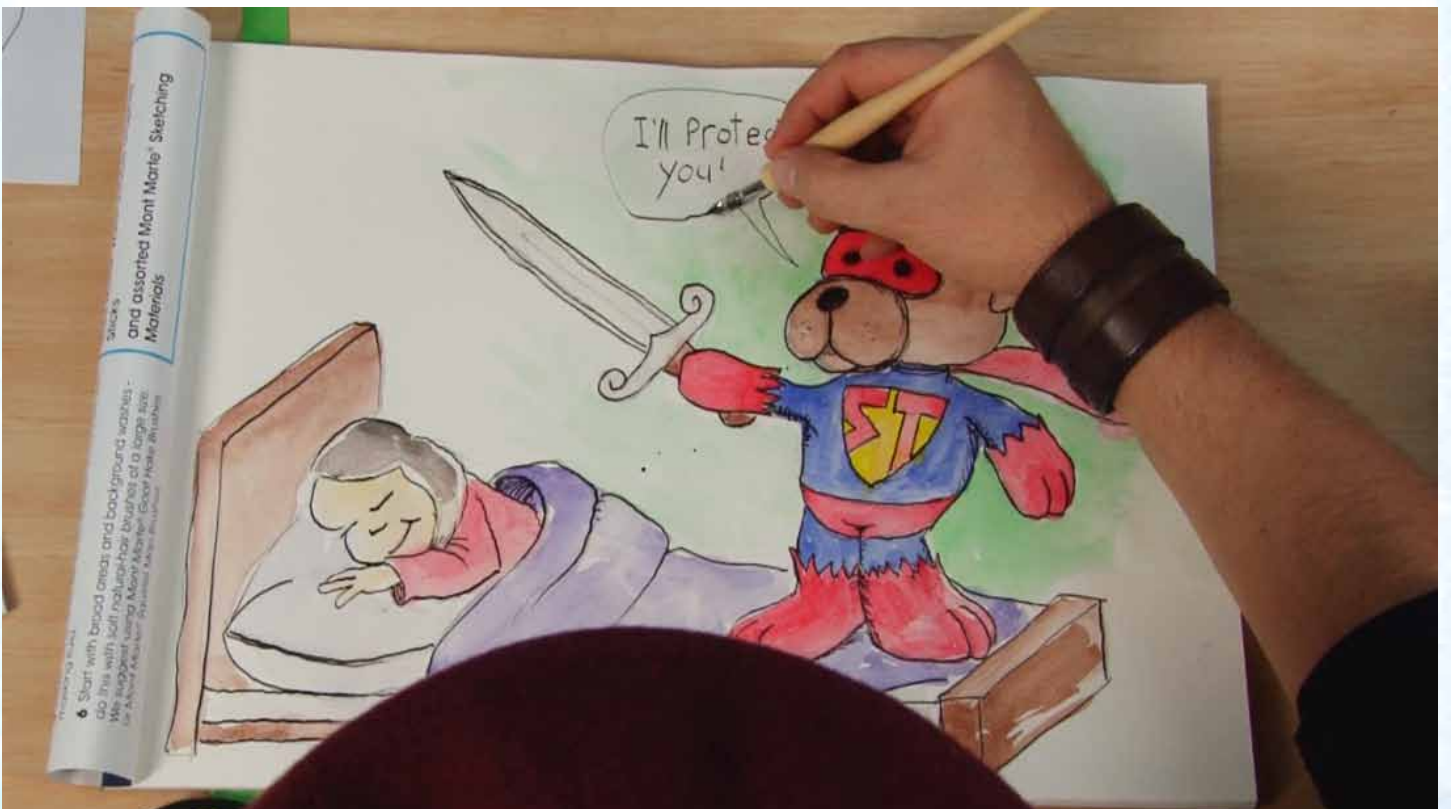
Step 5.

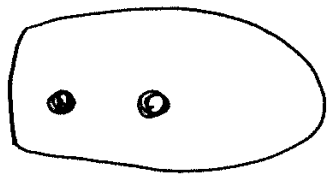
Use your dipper pen and some strong black watercolour paint to put outlines around your Teddy picture.



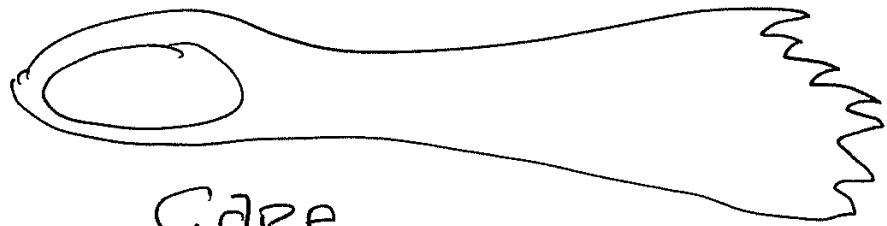
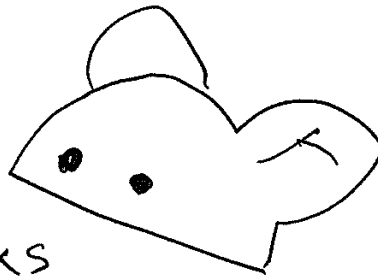
Step 6.
