

How to paint a trio of Kaleidoscope Kitties

..Hello and welcome to another fun lesson.
Today we'll be creating a Trio of Krazy Kaleidoscope
Kitties in Acrylic paint so.....



What we used:

CSST3060	Mont Marte Studio Single Thick Canvas 30 x 60
MCG0037	Mont Marte Acrylic Paints 12 pce 12 ml
MACR0003	Mont Marte Silver Series Foam Roller 75 mm
MAPL0002	Mont Marte Easy Clean Wood Palette
MAXX0019	Mont Marte Brush Washer Twin Compartment
PMSA0020	Mont Marte Silver Series Acrylic Silver 100 ml
PMMT0001	Mont Marte Metallic Acrylic 75 ml

Step 1. Silver Undercoat

First we must lay down an undercoat of Silver. Squeeze a thick bead of silver acrylic paint onto a palette and apply it with the 75 mm sponge roller. Make the coat as smooth and even as you can. Let this dry.



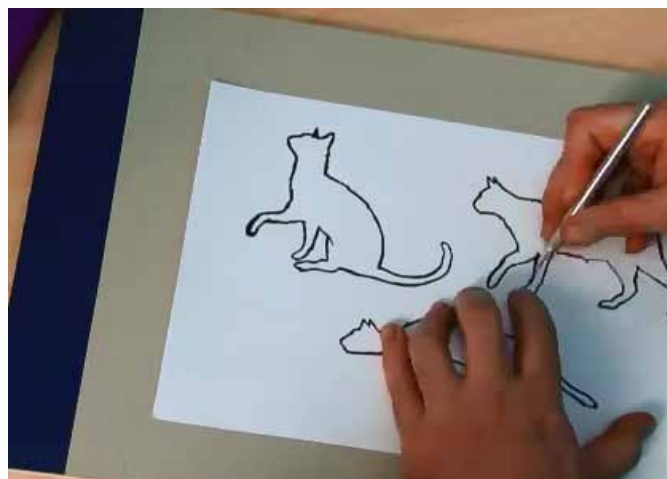
Step 2. Blue Skyline

Take some masking tape and apply a strip about 1/3 of the way down the canvas. Squeeze out a bead of metallic blue acrylic paint onto your easy clean palette. Apply this with a 75 mm sponge roller onto the top of the canvas.



Step 3. Creating the Stencils

CAUTION must be taken in this step
Refer to the last page of this PDF. Lay this sheet down onto a flat surface and cut the profile of each cat to the key line. Put the cut outs aside because we will use them in step 5.



When cutting out the stencils make sure you protect your work surface. You can use the card backing on a Mont Marte A3 Sketching Pad.



Step 4. Stencilling

Use masking tape to attach the stencil to the canvas in your chosen position. Squeeze a bead of lamp black onto the palette. With the 75 mm sponge roller lay the black into the cut out. Let this dry and then repeat this process with the other cats.



Step 5. Marking up the shadow area

Take the off cuts that were produced from step 3 and Blue Tak them under the appropriate cat's silhouette and about 1 cm from it. With a pencil draw the profile around the off cut and join the lines to each silhouette. Inside this shadow line create a series of shapes.



Step 6. Painting the shadow area

In the lesson painting I have used 9 colours from the Acrylic Paint Set. Squeeze out the colours you wish to use onto a palette. Paint in the shapes with a Mont Marte # 2 Taklon. Try to distribute the colours evenly and keep painting until all of the shapes are coloured.
